Reflecting on the exciting and complex results from recent HIV prevention research trials - including the CAPRISA microbicide study, the iPrEx and FEM-PrEP studies, and also the recent HPTN 052 treatment as prevention study - this meeting will address the issues related to the implications of these trials on the future pipeline of oral and topical pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) products.

Some of the topics that will be covered include: (a) what the ideal PrEP/microbicide formulation and active agent could look like in the future; (b) from an R&D perspective, how feasible will it be to develop such products in the near term; and (c) from an implementation/operational perspective, what could be the issues and challenges once brought to market. The future pipeline will have to address aspects of research, implementation, and integration to existing services for at-risk individuals.
