Andriy Klepikov is the Executive Director of the Alliance for Public Health, one of the largest HIV and TB focused NGOs in the country and in the region. Being its founding director, he is currently managing the organization with over 100 staff, implementing a complex and comprehensive HIV prevention, treatment and care program as well as other programs aimed at fighting TB, HCV and other diseases. Managing portfolio includes nation-wide, regional and global projects funded by the Global Fund, PEPFAR, the Dutch Government, France 5% Initiative and other donors.

Andriy is managing one of the largest harm reduction programs globally in partnership with field-level NGOs reaching over 200 000 people who inject drugs annually with its services, he is leading transitioning opioid-substitution therapy program (the largest in EECA region) to the state funding, he is managing TB / MDR TB program in Ukraine, leading advocacy efforts in access to Hepatitis C treatment including managing DAA treatment program for key populations with over 98% treatment success. In his capacity as Executive Director, Andriy also supervises the regional portfolio which includes over 20 countries of Eastern and Central Europe and Central Asia.

He received a PhD in philosophy in 1996 in Ukraine and did Post-Doctoral Studies & Research in Sociology being a Visiting Scholar at the Graduate Faculty, New School for Social Research, New York in 1996-1997. In 2008, he successfully completed executive management education program International Masters in Practicing Management which was run jointly by several universities / business schools led by INSEAD (France).

He is an elected member of the Developing Country NGO Delegation to the Board of the Global Fund to fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria (since April 2013), Chair of the Oversight Advisory Committee of TB Europe Coalition, and member of the Steering Committee of the Partnership 'Stop TB. Ukraine'.
