Keletso Makofane has worked in the global HIV response in different capacities, mainly focusing on HIV among gay men and other men who have sex with men. In South Africa, he managed a large HIV prevention and testing outreach program. He has provided technical assistance to community-based HIV programs in eastern and southern Africa. He has also conducted and published scientific research on health and human rights.

As part of his advocacy efforts towards an inclusive global HIV response, Keletso has served on a number of working groups and committees that influence the response. These include the recent IAS/Lancet Commission on the Future of Global Health and the HIV Response, the Global Advocacy Platform to Fast-track the HIV and Human Rights Responses with Gay and Bisexual Men, and the WHO Scientific and Technical Advisory committee on HIV and Viral Hepatitis.

Keletso is currently working towards a PhD in social epidemiology at Harvard University.
